Summary Duties

In connection with miscellaneous construction, alteration, and repair activities at various locations in the Power System, directs and, when supervising less than six (6) journeymen, participates in the work of a crew of journeymen and their helpers engaged in laying brick, terra cotta, hollow tile and similar building blocks used in constructing walls, partitions, arches, chimneys, smokestacks, and other structures; examines and interprets instructions, orders, plans and specifications, and observes and analyzes site of proposed work; plans, lays out and coordinates proposed work with other crafts; determines methods and tools to be employed, assigns and reviews tasks and assumes responsibility for quality and quantity of work during progress and after completion; encourages safe practices and enforces safety rules and precautions; approves workmen's time cards; makes oral and written reports on such matters as work progress, materials used, and accidents; hears and settles grievances or refers them to superior; and performs related duties.

1. Overtime:

For all time worked in excess of eight (8) hours per day Monday through Friday, and all time worked on Saturdays, Sundays, and recognized holidays, an employee shall be compensated at a rate computed by multiplying the hourly rate by two (2).

2. Holidays:

Recognized holidays shall be as follows: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Friday after Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. When a recognized holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed as a holiday.

4. Show-up:

An employee who reports for work at the regular starting time and for whom no work is provided shall receive pay for two (2) hours at the stipulated rate for so reporting, unless he has been notified before the end of the last preceding shift not to report.
