### Summary Duties

In connection with miscellaneous construction, alteration, and repair activities at various locations in the Power System, assists journeymen in the work of applying plaster to walls and ceilings, mixes mortar and plaster; assists in the erection of scaffolding; obtains and furnishes tools for journeymen as instructed; and performs related duties.

#### 1. Overtime:

Employees shall be compensated for each hour of overtime worked on Sundays and holidays (or holiday equivalents), at a rate computed by multiplying the appropriate hourly rate by two (2); for each hour of all other such overtime at a rate computed by multiplying the appropriate hourly rate by one and one-half (1½).

#### 2. Holidays:

Holidays shall be as follows: New Year's Day, Decoration Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. When a recognized holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Mondays shall be observed as a holiday.

#### 4. Show-Up:

An employee who reports for work at the regular starting time and for whom no work is provided shall receive pay for two (2) hours at the stipulated rate for so reporting, unless he has been notified before the end of his last preceding shift not to report.

An employee who reports for work and for whom work is provided shall receive not less than four (4) hours pay and if more than four (4) hours are worked in any one (1) day, shall receive not less than a full day's pay therefor.
